RESOLUTION 2012-11-159

Council Member Lobell moved to approve the following Resolution 2012-11-159 and was seconded by Council Member Carra. Motion carried by the following roll call vote.

**AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH OF RARITAN TO ENTER INTO A
“HURRICANE SANDY NEG WORKSITE CONTRACT AGREEMENT” WITH
THE SOMERSET COUNTY BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS**

WHEREAS, the Somerset County Board of Chosen Freeholders has offered to provide temporary workers to assist the Borough of Raritan with clean-up efforts following the devastating Hurricane Sandy, pursuant to a “Hurricane Sandy NEG Worksite Contract Agreement”; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Raritan has a need for temporary workers in its Department of Public Works;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Raritan that the Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into the “Hurricane Sandy NEG Worksite Contract Agreement” on behalf of the Borough, for the following purposes:

1. The Borough will accept workers employed by the County within its Public Works Department;
2. The workers shall be County employees on loan to the Borough;
3. Workers provided by the County shall at all times remain employed solely by the County;
4. There shall be no charge to the Borough for workers loaned by the County;
5. Workers loaned by the County shall be physically fit for general duties within the Department of Public Works;
6. The number of workers, hours of work, and days of work shall be as agreed between the Borough Administrator and the County;
7. The specific duties of the workers within the Borough Department of Public Works shall be as directed by the Borough Superintendent of Public Works.
