### February 18, 2015 Minutes

#### **Report from Boro Council Representative** (as reported by Mr. Lobell)

1. The Budget was increased to add a Fibrillator at the pools.
2. There is a possibility that the Cardinal Woods Park might close. It has not really been used by children; there have been reports of partying going on and vandalism. We would like to see a gravel walking trail on the outskirts of the park. Also, the tot climber and pavilion could be used at one of the other parks. A motion was made by Mr. Windrem and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ms. Snyder to close the Cardinal Woods Park. The motion was approved and Mr. Lobell will present this to the Boro Council.

#### **Report from the Recreation Director**

1. There will not be any wrist bands at the pools this year. Kevin Stianchi will be the Supervisor of the Pools. (He will train the lifeguards among other duties.) There will not be any Arts & Crafts at Cardinal Woods and Elizabeth Avenue Parks; however the Arts & Crafts will be 1-1/2 hours at Basilone and Frelinghuysen Parks.
2. The *Breeze* publication would like to have a column devoted to Raritan Recreation.
3. The attendance policy for Recreation is that any member must attend at least 9 months of meetings during the year.
4. The USA Soccer Sports Camp would like to run a camp for one week this summer. They would supply the instructors and equipment. This will have to go out to bid.
5. It was suggested we have other activities taking place at Opening Day, Some possible

activities are a Parade, Homerun Derby and other competitions. We will also serve hot dogs to all present.

6. The Easter Egg Hunt will be held March 28, rain date April 4.

**New Business**

1. Mr. Windrem made a motion, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Sinagra to appoint Lisa Snyder as Chairperson of Recreation. Mr. Windrem made a motion, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ms. Snyder to appoint Nicole Patente as Vice-Chairperson. Everyone approved these appointments.
