1. Mrs. Schulte reported the following balances:

Others account - \$21,000 (temporary budget)

1. Mr. Don Tozzi, our liaison from Council for Special Events, reported that the Duck Race would be held on October 16.

**Sports Events**

1. Mr. LoCascio said he has one person interested in the Pool position.
2. He will check with Fr. John from St. Ann's Parish to see if we can use the gym for Zumba.
3. Baseball registration is ongoing at this time. Registration will be \$60 per child and \$20 for another child from the same family.
4. There was a discussion on possible changes in the summer camp, which may include having a sports clinic optional to campers. This will be discussed further at next month's meeting.

**Questions and Comments from the Public**

1. Mr. Bob Hurte from Catholic Charities explained the Senior Shopper Program. To be eligible for this, a senior citizen would first need to be referred from the Office on Aging. After background checks and fingerprinting, volunteers would be matched with the Seniors. We will post this information to see if there is any interest in the community.

1. The "I Love Raritan" contest has 40 plus submissions so far. March 2 will be a Pizza Party for the contestants and the art work will be hung in the Community Room at the Municipal Building.

2. Raritan's 70<sup>th</sup> Birthday Party will be held on May 5, rain date May 6, at Frelinghuysen Park from 1-3pm. Businesses and organizations will be contacted to see if they would like to have a table to display their information.
